**Exhibitors please note:** A recording fee and event fee will be required of each dog and are included in the entry fees. These fees are to be collected by the show-giving club and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class, the fees are to be collected on the first entry only at each Obedience trial. Fees are collected on each Rally entry. Rally and Obedience are each separate trials. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2).

Only entered dogs are permitted on the grounds. Any dog causing a disturbance must be removed from the ring area. All dogs must be on leash at all times, except when being judged. No exercise pens or grooming allowed. Please stack crates. The Trial Chairperson and committee members reserve the right to ask you to move crates in order to keep aisles clear and the area safe. **DOGS MAY NOT BE LEFT IN THE BUILDING OVERNIGHT, HOWEVER, CRATES MAY BE LEFT OVERNIGHT SATURDAY NIGHT.** Dogs and equipment must be removed immediately following the second obedience trial on Sunday. Please clean your crate area and clean up after your dog.

Entries should be typed or printed, except for the proper signature, on Official American Kennel Club entry forms only. Incomplete and/or illegible entries will not be processed. Include only AKC titles on the entry form. Telephone entries, credit card entries, faxed entries and entries sent by a method requiring a signature will not be accepted. Please make checks payable to JBKC. All changes, alterations, cancellations of entries before the closing date must be legible, must include the AKC name and number of the dog, and must include the signature of the owner or his or her duly authorized agent. If, because of weather, riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of JBKC it is impossible to open or complete any of these trials, no refund of entry fees will be made for the affected trial.

A refund of the entry fee less \$5.00 for an entered bitch that comes in season after entries close will be made upon presentation of a statement by a licensed veterinarian to the Trial Secretary at least one-half hour before judging commences on the day of the trial (Rally and/or Obedience). Exhibitors from outside Wisconsin must comply with the following regulations. Wisconsin Department of Agriculture Rule enacted in 1954. No person shall import a dog over 6 months of age into this state unless an interstate certificate including thereon a report of vaccination of rabies accompanies it. Such vaccination shall be conducted not more than 12 months prior to entry. Provided that when chick embryo vaccination is used, such vaccinations shall be conducted not more than 36 months prior to entry. An interstate health certificate shall be executed by a veterinarian of the State of origin, showing animals identified thereon have been inspected and no infectious diseases disclosed and to include a rabies report.

**Food:** The 4-H food crew will have food for sale both days of the trials.

AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event, and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of the dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim, and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury, or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. I (WE) AGREE THAT ANY CAUSE OF ACTION, CONTROVERSY, OR CLAIM ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO THE ENTRY, EXHIBITION OR ATTENDANCE AT THE EVENT BETWEEN THE AKC AND THE EVENT-GIVING CLUB (UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED IN ITS PREMIUM LIST) AND MYSELF (OURSELVES) OR AS TO THE CONSTRUCTION, INTERPRETATION AND EFFECT OF THIS AGREEMENT SHALL BE SETTLED BY ARBITRATION PURSUANT TO THE APPLICABLE RULES OF THE AMERICAN ARBITRATION ASSOCIATION. INSTRUCTIONS

1. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of a breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).

2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.

3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.

4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for a show closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any show for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
